#### **COMPASSION AT WORK**

Nazarene Compassionate Ministries works together with the church around the world to help people see the love of Jesus in action. Below, you will see four photos with icons. Each one represents a way that lives and communities are being transformed.

<u>Holistic Child Development</u> – seeks to help children grow spiritually, physically, intellectually, emotionally, and relationally.

<u>Women and Girls</u> – supports women and their families through small business creation, small-scale farming, literacy education, and more so that they know they are made in God's image.

<u>Clean Water</u> – provides communities with safe water through a WASH program that includes water supply, sanitation, and hygiene promotion.

<u>Refugee and Immigrant Support</u> – supports through education for children, emergency relief for families in crisis, support for families who have been resettled, and more.

## **KALEIDOSCOPE PAGE**


Nazarene Compassionate Ministries and Nazarene Missions International are two different ministries in the Church of the Nazarene. Each one has an important role in the church.

Nazarene Compassionate Ministries (NCM) partners with local Nazarene churches around the world to care for people with the love of Christ. Nazarene Missions International (NMI) is in every local church sharing about God's mission around the world and how people can get involved in that mission.

Many times NMI shares about what NCM is doing and where there are needs around the world. This encourages local churches to join in that mission of caring for people as a way to show how much Jesus loves them. It's a great way to work together.

As you color the Kaleidoscope, you will see the NCM logo on one side and the NMI logo on the other; they are joined by the heart and cross in the center. You will also notice some different icons. Many you have seen in other Kids Kaleidoscopes or on the previous page.
